Volunteer Coordinators

1. Keep updated list of age group coordinators and team parents.
2. Coordinate volunteers for opening and closing day activities.
3. Work with concessions to ensure that each team is scheduled and participates.
4. Provide information from the Board to the age group coordinators and vice versa to facilitate better communication to each team.
5. Communicate any changes in game schedules to the age group coordinators as soon as possible

Age Group Coordinators

1. Responsible for communications between the board and the team parents.
2. Assist the volunteer coordinators with making sure each team has volunteers for assigned concession duty, as well as opening and closing day activities.
3. Keep updated list of all team parents.
4. Be available to answer any questions or concerns.

Team Parents

1. Responsible for assisting the coach where possible with any communication to the parents.
2. Responsible for distributing information to the parents about any changes or news from the age group coordinators.
3. Provide list of volunteers from team for opening day, concessions and closing day activities.
4. Organize drink/snack list for games and/or practice.
5. Communicate any questions or concerns to the age group coordinators.

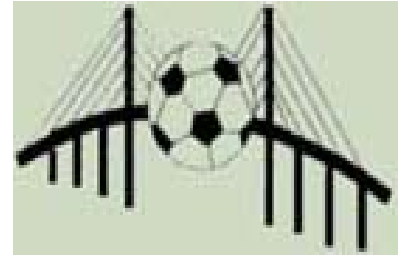
